Notes to Accompany the Sixth Year Subject Choice Form

1. Sixth year pupils must select subjects from the five columns of the S6 choice sheet which will involve a minimum of 24 periods of class contact. This can be achieved by choosing four subjects at Higher, Intermediate or Advanced Higher levels. It can also be achieved by choosing three subjects at Higher, Intermediate or Advanced Higher levels plus two Free Standing Units. Where a subject is not selected, then 3 or 6 periods of Supervised Study should be.
2. Most subjects are available at Higher, Intermediate 2 and Intermediate 1 levels.
3. Students will be placed in a course of the appropriate level, based on knowledge of the student's prior learning and results.
4. Each free standing unit is taught for three periods per week. A number of the free standing units will lead to a National Qualification in the subject area while others can lead to a 'Working With Others' NQ award.
5. **Column E Consortia Arrangements**
Column E of our senior timetable is designed to coincide with courses offered at the nearby Forth Valley College of Further and Higher Education (*formerly Falkirk College of Further and Higher Education*) and with a number of Higher and Intermediate courses run in other local secondary schools. Please study the sheet entitled 'Schools Links Programme' (*pages 83 – 124 in the Choices Booklet*) Arrangements for details of alternative courses which can be chosen in column E of the choice form
6. Full SQA Higher and Intermediate courses are made up of a series of units and there is a final exam. Please note that in order for a student to qualify for the full subject award, a pass has got to be obtained in every unit as well as a successful outcome in the final examination.
7. **A subject will run only if there is a viable uptake for it.**
