Why study Crime, Justice, Beliefs and Values?

This is a 2-year Level 5 course which explores Crime in the Community, Crime Scenes and the History of Criminology.

What will I study?

Learners will develop knowledge of why people commit crimes, how they are investigated and what crime tells us about the way people think. Pupils will also do a personal project centred around crime, belief and justice in the community.
